## Cultural Innopreneurship Fund

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#### Background:

Reveal, founded in 1980 and restructured in 2017, promotes informal learning and development across Europe. With the motto "...because learning happens everywhere!", Reveal supports non-formal learning for personal, professional, and community development, grounded in humanistic values and holistic learning.

Since 2021, Reveal has supported local arts and culture projects that promote sustainable development aligned with the SDGs.

#### Steps to Apply:

1. Align Your Project: Ensure your project supports non-formal learning and sustainable development.
2. Prepare Your Proposal: Detail your project's goals, methods, and expected outcomes. Proposal should not exceed 3 pages
3. Quantify Funding Needs: Request funding between 200 to 5,000€, demonstrating how it will achieve your goals. Co-funding is provided at 75-90%.
4. Submit Your Application: Contact Ms Law ([vlaw@blinc-eu.org](mailto:vlaw@blinc-eu.org)) with your proposal and funding request.
5. Evaluation: Reveal Association will review based on originality, sustainability, and professional quality.

Partnering with REVEAL, the Cultural Innopreneurship Fund is a financial support mechanism aimed at empowering individuals and organizations in the education, cultural and arts sectors to innovate and create impactful projects. This fund is designed to foster the development of creative and sustainable initiatives that bridge the gap between culture, education, and entrepreneurship, driving social and cultural change within communities.

Interested projects can apply for funding on a yearly basis and can get between 200€ and 5.000€ (75-90% funding) if they are selected by experts from the Cultural Innopreneurship experts within the reveal association.

REVEAL targets a yearly disbursement of 10.000€ for informal learning projects.
